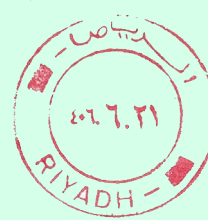
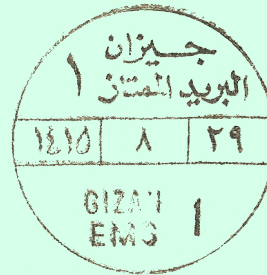



Fee Paid - General Information

The Arab revolt in the Hejaz started on 10 June 1916 and it was considered inappropriate to continue using Ottoman stamps on mail and so FEE PAID markings were introduced and used until Hejaz stamps became available. There were periods of stamp shortages and these marking appeared from time to time.

Many excellent Hejaz covers are illustrated in the exhibit shown in Random Notes #80.

In later years, FEE PAID marks were used on official mail allowing free passage through the postal system.

In the nineteen-seventies the number of official departments increased dramatically and it would appear that each department had its own handstamp device. Most of the departments were based in Riyadh and used mainly the [FP21](#), [FP22](#) and [FP23](#) designs and to collect all variations is probably an impossible challenge, not aided by the fact that so many impressions on mail were so poor.

On many examples of official mail, the only postal markings were the undated FEE PAID marks, thus providing a challenge to chronological listing of these marks. The dates provided in this section are for guidance only and there are bound to be earlier and later dates in existence.

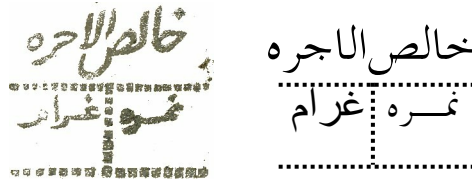

This type was renumbered in Random Notes #53 because it was thought that all used examples originated in Jeddah, one having an Alexandria mark for 29 August 1916 and a Jeddah mark for 21 August with an unclear year. An example in the Al Thani collection shows the mark adjacent to a MEKKÉ 3 cancel for 17 August 1916.

Notes

This type, in red, is also found on mail from Makkah in September 1926. It was reported in an unknown reference that it was used on pilgrim mail, but the dates do not coincide with the Hajj of that year. There are differences between the black and red versions, and although one item has an APA certificate, this red fee paid device is questionable.

The three examples seen have a Makkah cancel dated 12-3-1435 (20 September 1926).

In this group, the fourth line is curved to fit the circle and contains a *lam-alif* ligature with *alif* crossing *lam*.

There are many variations of this type, and most of those seen have poor impressions. It is not considered worth categorizing these variations until better examples are available. In some cases it is not possible to determine whether the circle is a single or double line.

As a guide to the reader, 9 designs have been recorded in three colours and sizes ranging from 34 to 40 mm.

There are many variations of this type, and most of those seen have poor impressions. It is not considered worth categorizing these variations until better examples are available. In some cases it is not possible to determine whether the circle is a single or double line.

As a guide to the reader, 6 designs have been recorded in two colours and sizes ranging from 33 to 36 mm.

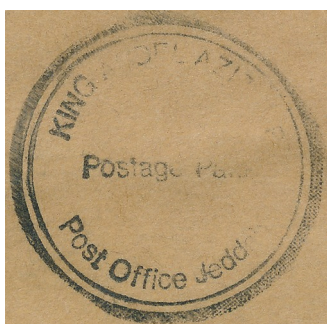

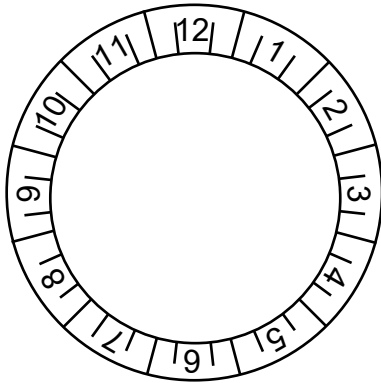
Al Barid Al Mumtaz - Notes

These postmarks present us with the usual problem of poor application and consequently the inability to catalogue properly all of the examples seen. What follows in this section is the best we can do with the available material.

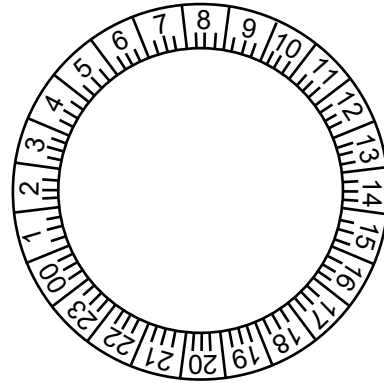
The cancels have been grouped according to their shape to aid identification.

The 'Clock' cancels

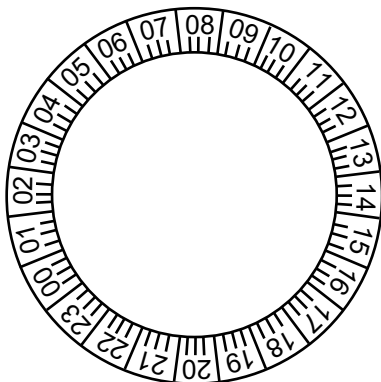
The most frequently seen cancels are those where the details are surrounded by a clock face, usually a 24 hour clock but 12 hour do exist. The hours are numbered and both Eastern and Western Arabic numerals are known, although Eastern Arabic has not been recorded on a 12 hour clock. The Western Arabic numerals are known with or without leading zeroes on single digit numbers.



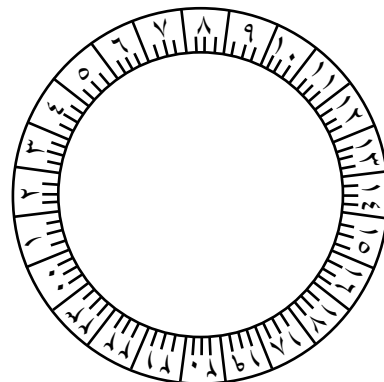
12 hour

The time pointer

Underneath the ring of hours is a pointer symbol which is adjusted to point to the time of posting. The types of pointers seen are shown below, but not all examples display a pointer.



Colours

The colours of the postmarks are not exact. Many offices used different colours and sometimes these got mixed or devices were not cleaned before a new ink was added. There are many shades between the violet and blue impressions resulting from these mixes.

Terminology

The terms monolingual and bilingual refer to the text on the postmark but ignore the language of the date.

Additional collecting interest

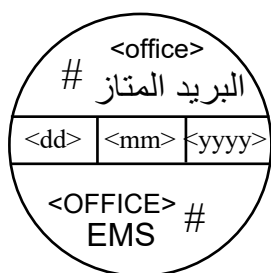
Most examples seen on cover are used in conjunction with a postal meter mark. The international postage rate for express mail was 100 riyals but the maximum amount the postal meter could display was 99.99 riyals. Some covers seen use two meter marks adding up to 100 riyals, but there are some with a single mark with the extra 0.05 riyals unaccounted.

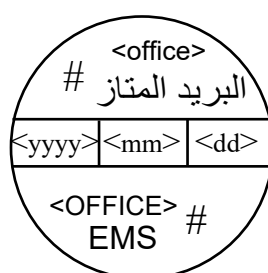
An example of a postmark showing a 24-hour clock with Eastern Arabic numerals and inscribed in Arabic *Al Barid Al Mumtaz*, has been seen from the SpeedPost Agency, number 11/14, in the Al Shimaisi district of Riyadh. This is not a Saudi Post Barid Al Mumtaz postmark but a normal agency postmark used to cancel stamps.

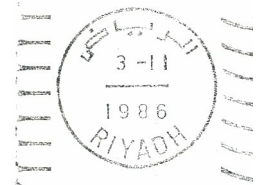
In his series of articles in Random Notes, Ken Knight provided a detailed description of this mechanical cancellation and an updated version is reproduced here.

This type of cancellation consists of two bilingual single ring datestamps. One datestamp has Hijri date, the other one a matching Gregorian date. The two datestamps are spaced 40mm. apart by either six or seven wavy lines. Some offices, e.g. Dammam, have been noted using both.

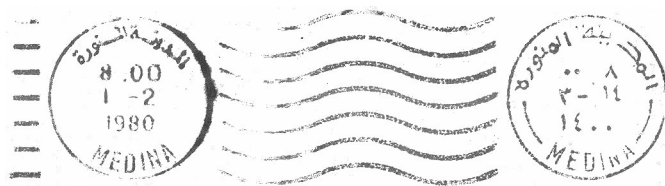


Typical cancellation with inverted wavy lines

The only constant parts of this datestamp are the short straight lines which occur at the right hand and left hand extremes. Even the wavy line matrix can be removed and reinserted, or perhaps it is a case of inserting the date circles upside down, then inverting the whole cancellation, regardless, the effect is the same - inverted wavy lines. There is no official definition as to what constitutes upright or inverted wavy lines. If we consider types MC01, MC02 and MC03, where only one direction is known, then upright lines are those where the line ends point slightly upwards.



The greater number of variations occur in the makeup of the circles, the most obvious difference being the presence or omission of the "arc lines" inside the circles. That arc lines are a variation and not a different datestamp is proved by the fact that examples are to be found with one circle having "arc lines" and the other not having them as per the example from Medina illustrated below.



Another date circle variation concerns the Arabic town name. Three different styles of Arabic script have been noted and are described here, but to make things interesting some offices have several variations. All three types are shown for Dammam to assist the reader to distinguish between types.

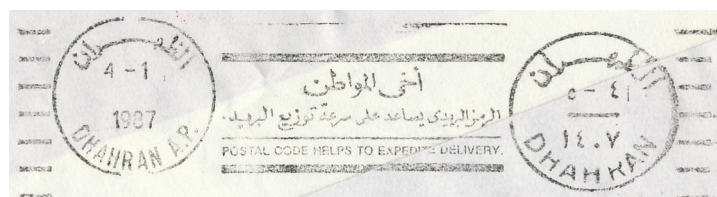

Script size

The western script occurs in two sizes, narrow and wide. The only offices recorded to have used both western scripts are Dammam, Dhahran, Jeddah, Makkah and Riyadh. In the case of Makkah, the smaller western script is recorded only where the Arabic reads Makkah Al-Mukaramah, and the larger western script only where the Arabic reads simply Makkah. Both scripts are 2.25mm. high, but the difference in overall word length is easily seen. With Dhahran, Jeddah and Riyadh the length of the horizontal bar of the letter 'H' varies from 0.6mm. wide on the narrow script to 0.75mm. on the wide western script..

That the use of a specific western script is not dependent upon the particular Arabic script in use is demonstrated by the mixed scripts which are to be seen used in conjunction with both boxlike and the fluid Arabic scripts. There is one exception to this in that the fluid script for Jeddah is dependent on the western text size as previously noted. The cancel shown below shows the narrow and wide western scripts in use with the same fluid Arabic for Dhahran. Of interest is that one of the western scripts is for DHAHRAN A.P. and the other for DHAHRAN.



Narrow and wide western scripts

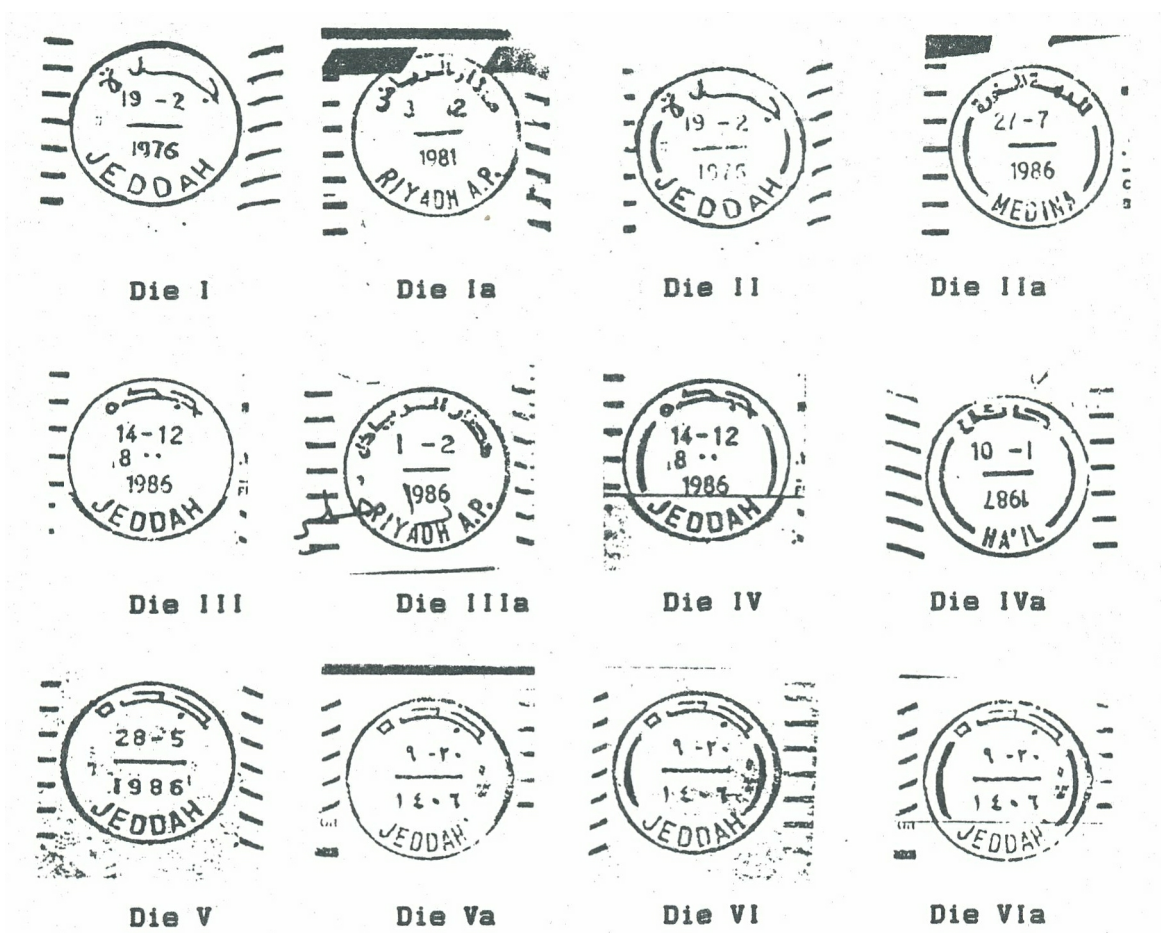

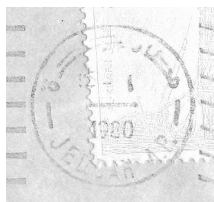

Errors

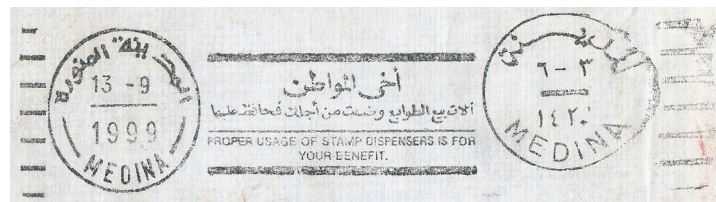
Because the components of the cancellation are set manually, there is the opportunity for errors. We are not to be disappointed!

Office names, time, day, month, year, wavy lines and slogans can all be found inverted and in different combinations. One or more components can be found omitted. Occasionally there are errors of the value, such as incorrect year. Some of these are mentioned in the notes applicable to the cancellation type, but more to add some interest rather than completeness. Many errors are transient and two examples are shown below. One is where an Arabic numeral was inserted in a Gregorian date and the other where possible wear caused MEDINA to appear as MEOINA. Whatever the cause, it was corrected.

It can be difficult to determine what the error actually is. There are instances where both date circles are inverted and the wavy lines or slogan is upright; or are the circles upright and the wavy lines or slogan inverted?

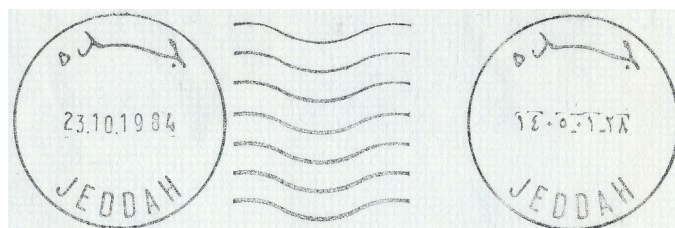

Postage Meter Marks - General information

The series of articles in Random Notes '*The Postal Markings of Hejaz, Nejd, Hejaz and Nejd, and Saudi Arabia By: Kenneth D. Knight*' did not include postal meter marks. This section provides basic information about the marks, describing the design, the offices using them and an indication of the period of use. Details of the machine serial numbers and the date errors and varieties, franking errors, etc., that may be encountered are more fully described in the '*One Man's Collection*' noted below.

The usage date ranges quoted have been obtained from just one collection which, although extensive, will not contain the full range of usage and are therefore given for guidance only.

Some meter marks have a lower case letter following the numerals the meaning of which is:

- a Postal agency mark
- s Postal meter mark contains a slogan

The MCL types stated for all types are the type codes assigned to the meter marks in the book noted below and may have been referred to in Random Notes:

*One Man's Collection - Part 1 - Saudi Arabia: Modern Technology (1970 - 2018),
First Edition 2018, by Martin Lovegrove, ISBN: 978-0-9558246-1-6.*

Also in that book are extensive details about the machine serial numbers, locations, usage, errors and varieties

Normally a meter machine is associated with an office, but some re-allocation occurred in Jeddah, e.g. P.B.0947 has been associated with JEDDAH-12, JEDDAH-70 and JEDDAH-73. P.B.0953 also appeared as PB953.

Dates seen range from 1978 to 2012 and as such would suggest that this type was the first to be introduced for general use. This type was the early workhorse of meter machines.

Date Formats

Dates are usually Hijri dates but some Gregorian examples are known, mainly from Eastern Province. The Gregorian dates can be verified by other postal markings or the fact that the item was an entry into the 1995 Brylcreem competition.

Serial Numbers

Generally the serial number is PB followed by five digits, but there are exceptions. There are some that continue the sequence of PM02, and those seen by the author are in the range 1808 to 1851 with a prefix of either PB or P.B. Can we make the assumption that these were the first of a new order?

There are some anomalies in this batch. RIYADH-1 PB1812 has a serial of PB20039 but RIYADH-1 PB1813 has a serial number of PB1813. There are other examples for the enthusiast to discover.

Introduction

Type PM07 appeared at a number of locations with a Saudi Arabia, Kingdom of Humanity slogan added and has been allocated the type PM07s. Dates seen range from 19 February 2006 to 21 May 2006, however this did cover only 26 items. The only date format seen is YYYY_MM_DD and all had a small Arabic number 4 for the century. The date numerals are all neat.

The slogan appears to have been manufactured from rubber and degraded significantly from a reaction to the ink.

None of the slogans seen in type PM02s have been used with PM07s.
