Spink are proud to present the “Maurice Jacob” Collection of Saudi Arabia stamps and postal history. Please click on the link to be taken directly to the sale for which bidding is open now and will close on 13 May. The sale covers all aspects of Saudi Arabian philately, starting with the Egyptian and Ottoman Post Offices, the Hejaz, continuing with the Nejd Occupation of the Hejaz, Hejaz and Nejd and finally the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The strength of the collection lies with the period of the Nejd occupation of the Hejaz, one of the most significant periods in the history of Saudi Arabia. In this section will be found remarkable blocks of rare stamps, covers (which are largely unknown for this period), errors and varieties, such as two of the six known examples of the popular 1925 Capture of Medina Commemorative 1 piastre on 10 piastre imperforate between horizontal pair The undoubted star of the show is lot 83, a remarkable registered “front” which bears (amongst others) three examples of the astonishingly rare “Matbua” 1/8 piastre chestnut along with one example of the even rarer ½ piastre scarlet and to cap it all two examples of the “Nejd Sultanate Post” 1/8piastre chestnut (one with handstamp inverted), the rarest of all Saudi Arabian stamps. This fabulous item is signed by the famous Egyptian stamp dealer Albert Aide and is also accompanied by a British Philatelic Association certificate of authenticity signed by Peter Holcombe, the famous expert on Saudi Arabian stamps. Each lot in the sale is fully illustrated.

In addition to the Hammer Price, the Buyer must pay the Buyer's premium at a rate of 20% of the final Hammer Price.

SAUDI ARABIA

THE FIRST STAMPS OF HEJAZ WERE NOT ARABIAN BUT EGYPTIAN WITH "GEDDA" CANCELLATIONS.

FROM JUNE 8, 1865 TO OCTOBER 30, 1881 EGYPT, THEN A SATRAPY OF THE OTTOMAN EMPIRE, HAD ONE HEJAZI POST OFFICE AT THE PORT OF JEDDAH (GEDDA). IT APPEARS THAT ITS PRIME REASON WAS TO SERVICE EGYPTIANS AS MOST COVERS ARE DIRECTED TO SUEZ (LETTER RATE ONE PIASTRE) AND SOMETIMES ONWARD TO CAIRO OR ALEXANDRIA (AT AN ADDITIONAL $\frac{1}{2}$ PIASTRE)

EFFECTIVE JULY 1875 UNTIL APRIL 1878 THIS RATE WAS AMENDED TO $1\frac{1}{2}$ PIASTRES TO ANY EGYPTIAN DESTINATION. THE POST OFFICE USED THE FOLLOWING CANCELLATIONS ON EGYPTIAN STAMPS AND INTERPOSTAL SEALS :-

This area of study is in dire need of more research. Only my poor collection and reference works such as, "Turkish Arabia", by Major T. L. C. Tomkins and "Turk Postalari Iik Filatelik Danga Ve Mohürleri" by Orhan Brandt & Sadik Ceylan, have been used to roughly place the numbers and varieties of cancellations. The illustrations that follow are just that, illustrations. Many errors and omissions will be found. It is known that negative seal types exist for Jeddah, Mecca, and Medina. I have not, unfortunately, good enough examples to illustrate. The year dates indicated are guesses as to the year of introduction for each type.

III. THIRD HEJAZ POSTAGE & DUE ISSUE

The sheets of roulette 20 stamps proved to be too fragile for postal personnel, thus unsatisfactory. It was requested therefore that all new orders for postage stamps be delivered serrate roulette 13. The Postmaster for His Highness Hussein ordered that two additional values of postage (1 para, 2 qersh) and three values of postage due (20 para, 1 qersh, 2 qersh) be designed and printed. The Survey of Egypt obliged.

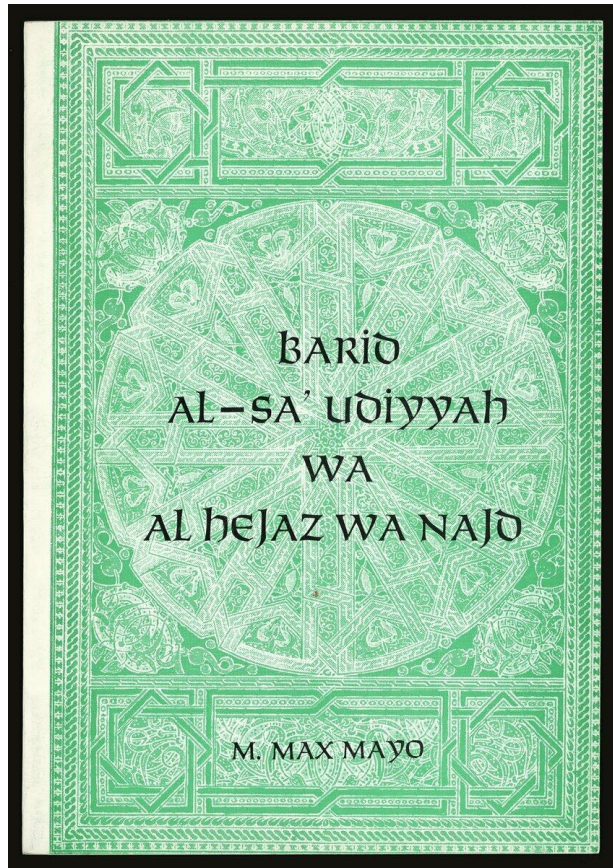

PRE STAMPS

On June 27th 1916, His Highness Hussein Ibn Ali declared the Hejaz free of Ottoman rule. With independence it was decreed that no Ottoman stamps were valid for postage. Inasmuch as no Hejaz stamps were yet at hand, "Fee Paid", handstamps were cut to be provisionally used to indicate payment of postage. Usually their application was accompanied by an impression of the cancelling device in use previously at each particular post office. The use of the "Fee Paid" cancels was short lived, genuinely, as indicated by the use dates given by Warin. Mecca 26.6.1916 to 4.10.1916 Taif 5.7.1917 to 9.8.1917 Jeddah 26.6.1916 to 4.10.1916 Yambo 3.8.1916 to 5.1.1917

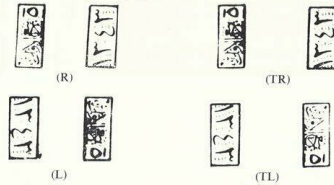

In these sheetlets, the paper is un gummed, porous, and natural in color. An examination of the illustration above will show the numerous varieties of se-tenant pairs that are possible. These sheetlets were also privately perforated and represented as errors of great scarcity.

XIX. JEDDAH CONTROL ISSUE

Due to leakage en route to Jeddah from the Cairo printers, all stocks were ordered overprinted with controls in black, red or blue. This order invalidated all stamps without the control. The control consisted of two rectangles. One with the year, "1343". The other with the day and month, "5 Rabi' al awwal". Warin in her very fine book goes into great detail with regards to this and the following issue. She describes three issues of controls. Two from Jeddah, and one from Cairo. I will, in the interest of brevity, make but two distinct issues. To distinguish this, the Jeddah issue from the forthcoming Cairo issue, note the following almost constant rules of difference: The size of the year tablet is seldom over 15mm long. The rectangles are imperfect. The frame lines are coarse with varying thicknesses. The lines or bars under and over the Arabic "3" in the month tablet are long and irregular. The colors are more vivid. The black is pitch, not greyish. The red is a bit orangier. The blue is deep, not greyish.



The normal positions for the tablets of the control are as depicted above. (R) & (TR) with the year tablet at the right, and (L) & (TL) with the year tablet at the left. However on occasion, one or both of the tablets may be inverted. A simple guide to follow is this: In the normal position, right or left, the Arabic "5" in the month tablet is always sitting directly opposite the rumps of the Arabic "3" of the year tablet.
