
One Para: Roulette 13

Apparently heavy wear caused a second printing of the "The Hashemite Arab Government 1340" to be enclosed by a frame. 340 sheets of the one para overprinted on 7th January 1922

D. F. Warin noted that the second, third and fourth printings were overprinted. However the Arabic control A-17 shown below confirms all 4 printings were overprinted. Note this magenta colour is subject to changes due to light or humidity.





The double framed overprint is the only variety known on the 2 piastre, and infrequently available.

Half & One Piastre Surcharges on One Para





250 sheets of one para were surcharged 'nesf qersh' half piastre, and 3,500 sheets 'qersh wahid' one piastre.

Varieties occurred on the one piastre surcharges - especially when sheets with an inverted framed overprint were to be surcharged. The press operator was never quite sure how to place the surcharge! The errors including partial inverts and transposed words come in complete sheets and therefore were either early setting errors or produced deliberately

Gold over Red Overprint

J. M. Wilson reports a single sheet, of which the bottom 25 positions are believed still intact. Gold flakes were sprinkled on wet red ink. Another sheet exists with gold flakes on blue ink.

Note: Gold overprints on the roulette 13 one quarter piastre stamps are relatively abundant.




